It gives me immense pleasure to present the Annual Report of our school, highlighting the major achievements, activities, and progress made during the academic year **2025–2026**.

The Annual Report showcases the achievements and glories of our school, but it also encourages us to reflect upon our shortcomings. We have always been committed to creating an environment that helps young minds blossom and provides a platform for individual thinking and the holistic development of a child’s personality.

We set standards and goals for ourselves and strive to achieve them in the areas of **academics, sports, discipline, leadership, and many more**.

JSS Public School, Chamarajanagara, established on **13th June 2014**, is now in its **12th academic year**. I feel honored and blessed to be a part of **JSS Mahavidyapeetha** for the last twelve years. On this occasion, I take the opportunity to thank the Almighty Lord Sri Shivaratrishwara for His abundant blessings and the guidance of His Holiness Jagadguru Sri Shivaratri Deshikendra Mahaswamiji, our beloved Secretary-1 **Sri S.P. Manjunath Sir**, all the officers of JSS Mahavidyapeetha, parents, and well-wishers.

Our school is a **co-educational CBSE-affiliated institution**, with one section in each grade from **Pre-KG to 10th Standard**. In the current academic year, we have **461 students**.

The academic session **2025–26** began on **26th May 2025**. In the first term, we had **90 working days**, and in the ongoing second term, we will have **148 working days**, making a total of **238 working days** in this academic year.

As per the calendar of events, we planned **four periodic tests and two term examinations**. So far, we have successfully completed **all 4 periodic tests and the mid-term examination** for classes from **LKG to 10th Standard**. The **Annual Examination** are yet to be conducted. The results will be announced in the month of April.

For **Grade 10 students**, we have conducted **three Pre-Board examinations** before the CBSE Board Examination. And the grade 10 students attended the Annual examination and successfully completed.

The academic year began on a wonderful note with the excellent results of the **Class 10 CBSE Board Examination**.

The result was declared on **13th May 2025**, and we are proud to announce that **JSS Public School achieved a 100% result for the sixth consecutive year**. A total of **24 students** appeared for the examination, and **12 students secured distinction**.

Kumari Harshitha N emerged as the **school topper with 97.4%**, and she also became the **district topper among CBSE schools in Chamarajanagara for the academic year 2024–25**.

We are also proud to share that **Abhishek N** secured **centum marks in Kannada** in the same examination.

Functions and Celebrations

This report is a sincere attempt to showcase the progress and achievements of the academic year **2025–26**.


